
About Us

Project Information

Ongoing maintenance of our facilities, structures, and pipelines is necessary to provide continuous wastewater service to our residents. Upcoming maintenance is scheduled at an underground diversion structure along Bushard Street just north of Ellis Avenue. This project will repair valves, concrete surfaces, and associated instrumentation and electrical components within OC San's Bushard Diversion Structure in the City of Fountain Valley. This structure helps to transport wastewater to OC San's two treatment plants.

Depending on the construction activity, work hours will vary between daytime, nighttime, and some Saturday work.

Critical portions of the project will need to be done at night between the hours of 9 p.m.- 5 a.m. due to lower sewer flows.

About the Bushard Diversion Structure

Several manhole covers are noticeable in the roadway surface on Bushard Street. These manholes provide access to a below grade large concrete structure, the Bushard Diversion Structure. This structure is critical to the conveyance of wastewater and is responsible for diverting wastewater flows through 8-ft diameter sewer pipelines to either the Fountain Valley or Huntington Beach facility for treatment.
