The project will rehabilitate sewer pipelines, manhole structures, and improve manhole access. The project also includes the rehabilitation of several sewer pipelines that cross under the freeway.

OC San is committed to protecting public health and the environment by proactively maintaining its infrastructure. The project is needed to enhance aging infrastructure and extend the lift of the regional sewer system.
