
Location: Los Alamitos Blvd. – DAY WORK BEGINS

Construction Activity

Daytime manhole construction work is starting on northbound Los Alamitos Blvd. between Farquhar Avenue and Center Way. This activity will require lane closures to accommodate the necessary equipment and construction. Nightwork will continue in other areas of Los Alamitos Blvd./Seal Beach Blvd. and Katella Avenue as indicated in the map below.

What to Expect

- Lane closures & turn restrictions
- Occasional crosswalk closures
- Potential temporary bus stop relocation for northbound routes at:
 - Bradbury Rd., Rossmoor Way, Orangewood Ave.
- Access to all business and homes will be maintained
