Ms. Wiborg joined OC San in April 2019 as the Director of the Environmental Services Department. She oversees the EPA-authorized Pretreatment Program implementation and enforcement, regulatory compliance for air quality, biosolids management, and ocean discharge, and one of the largest municipal laboratory and ocean monitoring programs on the west coast.

Lan began her public sector career as an environmental toxicologist at the City of San Diego, and later served as the Deputy Public Utilities Director overseeing Long-Range Water Resource Planning and Management, Grid-scale Hydropower Energy Storage System development, Integrated Regional Water Management, Recycled Water Distribution System, Sustainable Groundwater Management Act compliance, Watershed Protection, and Water Conservation Program

implementation and enforcement. She is a certified National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit writer and serves on multiple scientific advisory boards.

Lan is a proud graduate of UC Davis where her focus on human health culminated in Bachelor of Science degrees in mathematical psychology and exercise physiology. Recognizing the importance of environmental factors on public health, she later obtained a Master of Public Health degree from San Diego State University Graduate School of Public Health (SDSU GSPH). Lan was inducted into the International Honorary Society of Public Health in 2005 and received additional training in epidemiology and biostatistics at UC San Diego School of Medicine and Johns Hopkins University while pursuing a doctoral degree in public health. She held a faculty appointment at SDSU GSPH from 2014-2016 with distinction.
