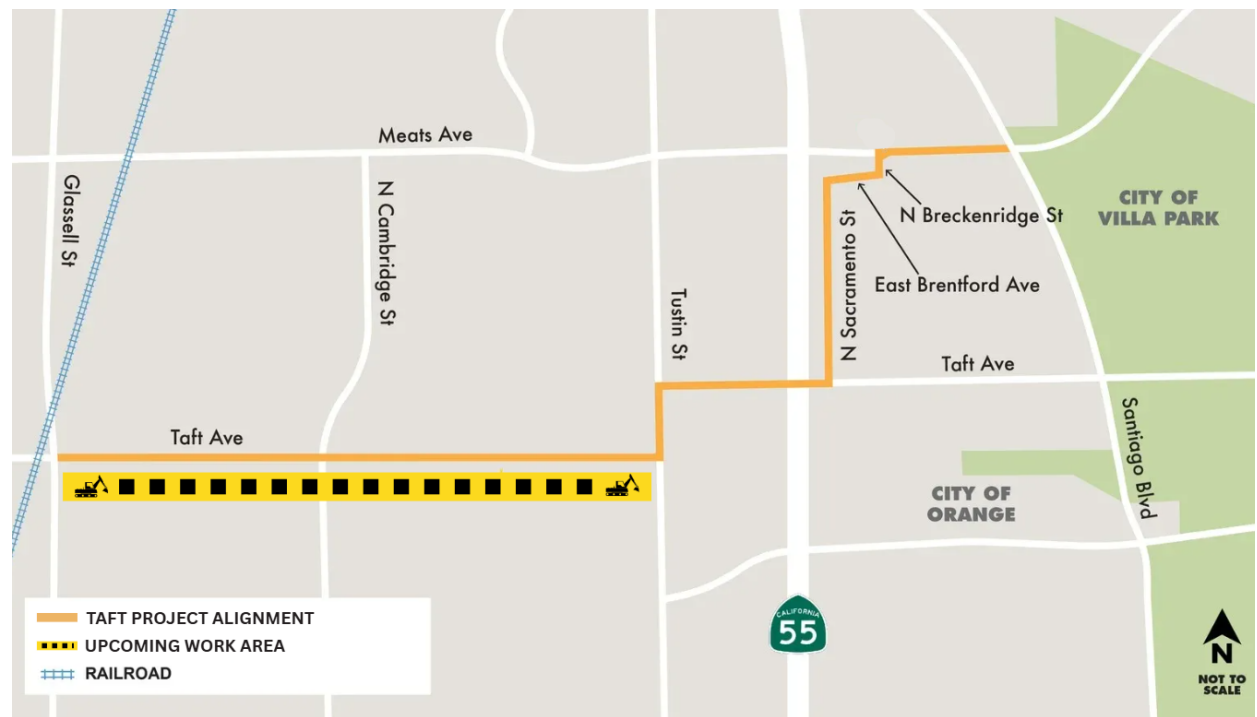




Taft Avenue Sewer Improvement Project

With pipeline abandonment coming to a close, crews are advancing into this final phase of construction on Taft Ave. Beginning the week of January 5, 2026 the Orange County Sanitation District (OC San) will begin paving Taft Ave. from Glassell St. to Tustin St. After paving, there will be final manhole work and striping for this portion of the project.

- **Location:** Taft Ave. from Glassell St. to Tustin St.
- **When:** Starting Jan. 5 and lasting up to 10 days.*
- **Hours:** 8 a.m. - 5 p.m.*
- **Impacts:**
 - Parking will be impacted during work hours.
 - Temporary traffic control while work is performed.
 - Access for through traffic will be maintained during construction.
