



Taft Avenue Sewer Improvement Project

Construction in the City of Orange is moving into new areas along the project route. To keep the project on schedule, two crews will be working at the same time on Tustin St. and E. Taft Ave. Street restoration will take place later in the project.

Crew 1 is finishing daytime work this month and will transition to nightwork at the Taft Ave. and Tustin St. intersection.

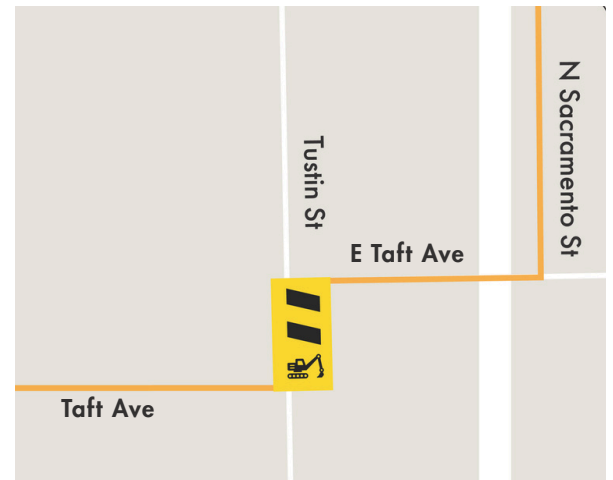
After completing this work, they will continue north on Tustin St. towards E. Taft Ave. The work will consist of trenching and pipeline installation.

- **When:** Week of December 1 until January 2026*
- **Work Hours:** Monday-Friday; 10 p.m.- 6 a.m.*

Crew 2 will start near the intersection of Tustin St. and E. Taft Ave. and continue east along the median past Sacramento St.

Work will begin with setting up K-rail for bypass installation and lateral relocations, then move into trenching and pipeline installation. Occasional night work may be needed to complete this phase of work.

- **When:** Week of December 1 until mid-February 2026*
- **Work Hours:** Monday – Friday; 7 a.m.- 6 p.m.*

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Project Description: The Taft Avenue Sewer Improvement Project will replace and relocate a portion of the Taft Ave. Sewer in the City of Orange.

This project will upsize almost two miles of pipe along Taft Ave. from Glassell St. to Sacramento St., northbound on Sacramento St. to Brentford Ave., to Breckenridge St. to Meats Ave. The current pipe ranges between 12 to 15 inches and will be upsized to 18 to 21 inches.

A portion of the sewer that currently runs along Tustin St. will be relocated to N. Sacramento St. where there is more room to install a larger pipe and facilitates the future maintenance of the pipeline.



Impacts:

- U-turns will not be allowed in or near the construction area during this phase of work.
- Flaggers will be present for the intersection work at Tustin St. and E. Taft Ave.
- A four-way stop will be in place near the intersection of E. Taft Ave. and Tustin St. during a portion of the work.
- Left turn restrictions will be in effect on E. Taft Ave.
- Bus stops in the area may be temporarily relocated.
- Expect dust, noise, and increased activity near the construction zone.
- Traffic control will remain in place at both work areas until each section is complete.

Stay Informed.

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The Orange County Sanitation District (OC San) is a public agency that provides regional wastewater collection, treatment, and recycling services for approximately 2.6 million people in central and northwest Orange County. OC San operates two facilities, 15 pump stations, almost 400 miles of regional sewer pipes, and treats around 190 million gallons of wastewater each day.
